WHY MOBILE PRENATAL CARE IS NECESSARY—ANOTHER STORY

If you remember in last months newsletter we shared a story of a young mother at risk that we used our mobile unit to serve. This month we have another story of a 15 year old, 30 weeks pregnant, abuse victim, and no prenatal care. Again, our triage nurse determined that we could not wait 10 days till our next scheduled clinic so we gathered a team and went to her with our mobile unit. It is fortunate we did. She had dangerously high blood pressure. After our visit we sent her to Hurley's triage unit where she was admitted to the hospital. Both of these patients were referred to us because of the work of the Pregnancy Resource Center of Flint who made first contact with them. This just confirms for us the importance of partnering with local PRC's and of having a mobile unit to use in circumstances where waiting for a regular scheduled appointment could be dangerous for Mom and/or baby. In one month 1 Mom and 2 babies who were at risk are now safe!
