### BUILDING PURCHASE UPDATE

We have received great news recently! The owner of our building that we have been leasing has lowered his asking price to less than \$90,000. A major contributor from Seattle, Washington has already donated \$24,000 towards this purchase and by good stewardship of your ongoing donations to help us “save babies, change lives, and help churches build community” since we began seeing patients in September 2020 we can use an equal amount from our current cash reserve towards this purchase. That means that if we can raise an additional \$42,000 over the next year towards this purchase we will own outright 5131 W. Bristol, Suite A with NO MORTGAGE OR LEASE PAYMENT to hinder our ability to carry out our mission.
